The Landscape Park

This walk will show you all the beauty of the Cranendoncksche Bosch and Boulder Broek areas. Here you will find the old, almost forgotten cultural landscapes of Brabant.

WP1 | N 51° 18.238' - E005° 35.344'

Nobleman Engelbert van Horne inherited some land near Maarheeze in the 13th century. The real castle of Cranendonck was probably build because of him. In 1673 French forces destroyed the castle.



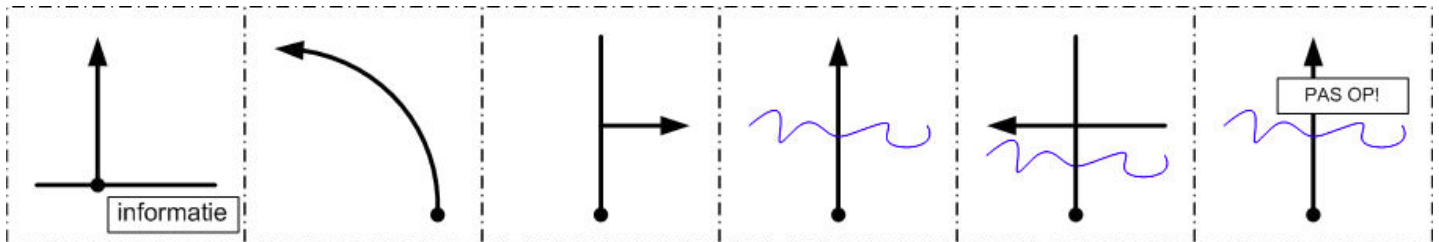
Near the grounds of the destroyed castle a farm was replaced by a villa in 1899 and a tower was added in 1917. This villa is now known as the Castle of Cranendonck and is used for the official marriage ceremony. You can park near the given coordinate.

The information panel in front of the castle shows some routes. How many kilometres is the Cranendonck Route? $A = \dots$

In 1996 some remains of the former castle were found in the back-garden. Nowadays some stone-filled items represent the outer walls. Also the old canals are represented by smaller stones.

WP2 | N 51° 18.(220+A)' - E005° 35.(100-A)3'

At this place the pasture is maintained in a natural way since 1997, which gives more flowers and more variety to this pasture. It looks really nice in spring.



Continue your walk on some smaller paths according to the given route.

- Pas Op "Sloot" gives 116
- Pas Op "Hier waak ik" gives 252
- Pas Op "Schrikdraad" gives 611

What text is on the sign at the back of the white tree? The white tree is in the middle of the path, right behind the bridge. $B = \dots$

WP9 | Word Search Puzzle

At the location where ditches come together used to be a metal object. The object is gone but there is still a yellow stone. What digit can be found the most as part of the telephone number? $T = \dots$

CACHE | N 51° 18.((M+P+T)-(CxK)-(A+B))' - E005° 3(P).(T)(K+P+T)'

Take the step into the field (left from the object: watch out; it can be slippery). You are allowed to walk through the field where crops are growing in the first part. The second part is still grass.

The cache is found about 10 metres behind the concrete poles.
